SEND FOAL HAIR SAMPLES WITH REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

- *Send foal hair for DNA with the registration application (except for registrations from the U.S.)
- *Pull 20-30 mane hairs, usually from the withers, or tail hairs.
Pull a few at a time, so you get the hair roots (that's the part with the DNA).
- *Tape the hair onto a clean sheet of paper across the middle of the sample.
DO NOT touch the hair roots (which may contaminate the foal's DNA).
- *Fold and seal it into a paper envelope (*never a plastic bag!*).
- * Write the pending name of the foal, its parents' names and your name on the outside.
- * Include with your foal's registration application.
