There was a great response to the "Dear Readers" section and I'm sorry there isn't room to include them all in this issue. However, you will all get a turn sooner or later, and thank you for writing.

#### Dear Readers:

I was interested in the open letter from Rocking Walker Stud Farm at Innisfree in the last newsletter regarding the operation of a breeding program.

For anyone new to the business of standing a stallion at stud, a feeling of apprehension is natural, and even for those who have been at it for several years, there are still many questions to be answered and problems that need to be solved. Human nature being what it is, as many people as you ask, that's how many different pieces of advice you'll get. It can be a bit confusing.

May I recommend that you contact the Horse Industry Branch of Alberta Agriculture and arrange for them to present their <u>Horse</u>
<u>Management Course</u> in your area. This excellent course covers in detail:

- Genetics, breeding programs, physiology of reproduction and foaling.
- Basic nutrition, including a study of the digestive system of the horse,
- Practical nutrition, including ration balancing and formulation.
- Horse health, diseases, parasites, unsoundness, lameness,
- General horse care and management.

There are many good educational films as well as study materials included.

The costs are minimal - \$10 per person or \$15 per family. This course is usually set up for a weekend, Friday evening and all day Saturday and Sunday. Twenty people would be enough for them to bring the course to you. These need not be members of a particular group or enthusiasts of any particular breed - just interested horse people. The only prerequisite for this course is a good foundation knowledge of horses.

It is really worthwhile and anyone from a "greenhorn" to seasoned horsemen could benefit.

We held this course in Lloydminster last November and everyone who participated said it helped them a lot.
